**JOIN PRESIDENT KENT FUCHS** to hear a presentation and participate in a Q&A with Political Science Professor and @ElectProject leader **MICHAEL MCDONALD**.

Professor McDonald will discuss his work tracking early voting activity in the 2020 presidential election. A record number of people have already voted early. Who are they -- and what does it mean for who will be president?

*Professor McDonald, who focuses on elections and voter turnout, is closely tracking early voter turnout in the 2020 presidential election through his @ElectProject. He is a co-principle investigator on the Public Mapping Project, co-authored Numerical Issues in Statistical Computing for the Social Scientist and has published research articles in dozens of academic journals. He has worked as a media consultant to the Associated Press, ABC, and NBC and published opinion articles in The Washington Post, USA Today, Politico and other media.*
