
African American History Meets Al in the 21st Century Classroom
















Faculty and student panelists will discuss how they are utilizing artificial intelligence to create instructional lesson plans from SPOHP's UF's Joel Buchanan African American Oral History Archive and make it accessible to scholars and K-12 students. Exploratory themes that will be discussed will be on curriculum and the uses of local history, the creation of lesson plans that honor African American language, and the implementation of Al normalizing linguistic variations.
